### Cool Kids Care



# Healthy Lunch Ideas!



#### Ham & Cheese Quesadillas

Spread mustard on a whole wheat tortilla, then top with slices of cheese and ham. Add a layer of baby spinach leaves, then fold to enclose and cook on a Panini press or in a hot skillet until the tortilla is golden and the cheese melts. Let cool slightly, then cut into wedges before packing.

#### Turkey & Cheese Pita Pockets

Spread a creamy cheese, such as Boursin, inside a whole wheat pita, then fill with roast turkey slices, baby spinach leaves and cucumber slices.





#### **BLTA Wraps**

Mash an avocado with lemon juice, then spread on a whole wheat wrap. Top with crumbled bacon, chopped tomatoes, and thinly sliced romaine lettuce. Roll up and wrap in parchment or wax paper to secure.
